SNAG Golf: Ages 4-6 years

Starting New At Golf (SNAG) is a great program for children to have FUN while learning golf fundamentals like: grip, stance, posture, alignment and golf terminology.

CCC Junior Golf - 3 Hole JCBT 200: Ages 7-9 years

This junior golfer is new to the game. This group will play a scramble format during all play days and focus on proper etiquette with treating fellow golfers with respect is the most important aspect students will learn in this group.

CCC Junior Golf -6 Hole JCBT 200: Ages 9-11 years

This junior golfer is beginning to enjoy the game of golf and is now wanting to learn to play his or her own ball instead of the younger, less experienced scramble format. Junior's will play the same tees as they did in 3-Hole group but, using his or her own abilities to complete each hole.

CCC Junior Golf -6 Hole Red/Gold: Ages 11-12 years

This junior golfer is beginning to find his/her way around the golf course and are developing his or her swing. This group moves back to the assigned tees to increase the difficulty of the game. The Rules of Golf become very important as this is when most juniors will play their first official tournament. Instruction for this group will increase.
